Joanne Lillpopp is the wife of former Christ Church Rector, Rev. Donald R. Lillpopp, and from 1980 – 1998 was a vital voice for the youth and music programs at the church. Joanne was instrumental in developing and nurturing the youth through her development, implementation of, and continual involvement with Christian Education, as well as being an active Choir member, an advocate for the Youth Chorus, and a strong supporter of all parish music programs.

The deadline for applications is *Friday, January 13, 2017*; those received after this date will not be considered.

Requirements for the applicant include:

Applicants must demonstrate interest and aptitude in music. They must also demonstrate a degree of musical potential and commitment. Applicants will be required to have an interview with the CCSArts Scholarship Committee, and must submit a completed application form which will outline their reasons for requesting aid, their desire to study music, and the importance of music in their life.
